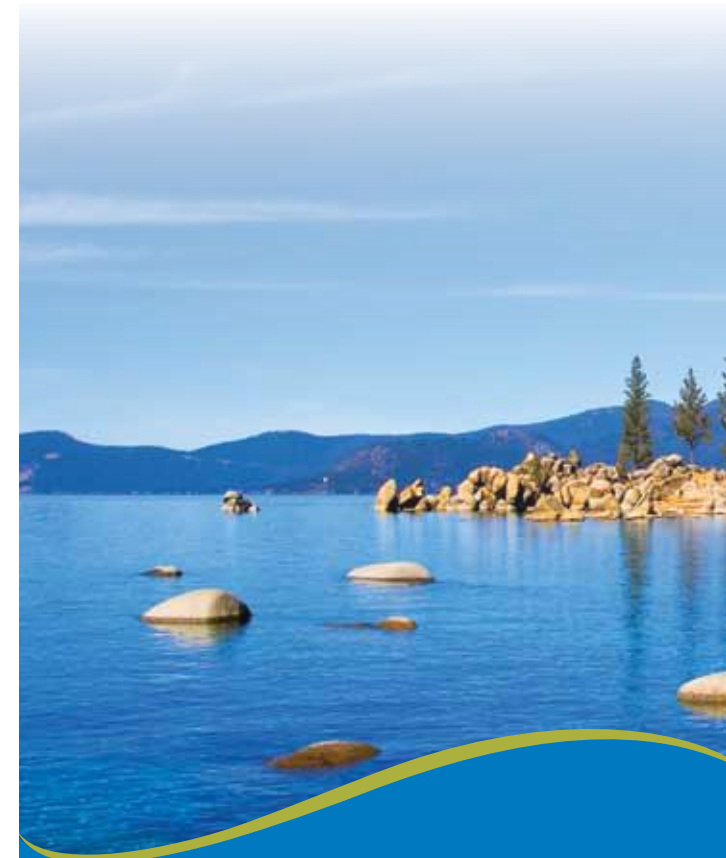

Preparing For Your Surgery

Please read this information carefully and follow all instructions. This will help to assure that your surgery will not be postponed or canceled.

- You will be contacted by a nurse who will ask you questions regarding your medical history and confirm any necessary medical tests required.
- It is very important that you arrive at Lake Tahoe Surgery Center at the time indicated.
- Do not eat or drink anything after midnight unless your physician instructs you differently.
- You should bathe or shower and brush your teeth without swallowing the water the morning of your surgery.
- A responsible adult must accompany you to the facility and be present when you are ready to leave. We suggest one person per adult patient, and we welcome both parents of pediatric patients. Parents are advised to remain on site during the procedure.
- Please remove all make-up.
- Jewelry should be left at home. If you wear contact lenses, please bring a case for safekeeping.
- We suggest that you wear loose, casual clothing. A patient gown will be provided. If you prefer, you may bring a robe and slippers to wear home.
- Note: If you experience any changes in your health between the time you last saw your surgeon and the date of your scheduled procedure, please notify your surgeon. This would include a cold, cough or fever.

When You Arrive For Your Surgery

Once you arrive at the Lake Tahoe Surgery Center, you will meet with a staff member to complete the registration information. To prepare for your surgery, you will be escorted to the pre-operative area where you will meet the surgical team.

After Your Surgery

Please follow these general rules that complement the instructions you will receive from your physician.

- A physician will authorize your discharge from Lake Tahoe Surgery Center.
- Follow your physician's instructions regarding diet, rest and medication.
- We advise patients not to drive, make important decisions or sign important documents for at least 24 hours following the procedure. Please have a family member, close friend or responsible adult drive you home.
- Plan to have someone stay with you for the first 24 hours after your procedure.

Our staff will call to check on your progress and answer any questions. If you should have any specific questions about your recovery, please call your physician.

Financial Arrangements

Lake Tahoe Surgery Center accepts most types of insurance. Preliminary insurance information will be obtained from your physician's office at the time your procedure is scheduled. A Surgery Center staff member may contact you to discuss your insurance coverage prior to surgery. Payment of your co-insurance payment and deductible is expected in advance of the procedure.

Please be aware that this facility fee DOES NOT include fees for your surgeon, consulting physician, laboratory services or anesthesiologist.

Some procedures require full payment in advance of the procedure.
